Marsha Ingersoll elected to lead national Chums, Inc.

On October 18, 2025, Marsha Ingersoll was elected the 21st National President of Chums, Incorporated, a national 501C3 organization of women across the United States who use their talents in service to their communities.

Ms. Ingersoll is a charter member of the Oklahoma City chapter, which was chartered in 2007. Chums, Inc. was established in 1946. Ingersoll has served on the national level since 2014, when she was first elected National Recording Secretary. She also served as National Financial Secretary from 2018-2021, and as National Vice President from 2022-2025.

Ms. Ingersoll is an active member of the Oklahoma City chapter, having served as chapter

president, treasurer, financial secretary, and parliamentarian.
